

We are informed by a correspondent from Lawrenceville, Gwinnett county, under date of the 7th inst. that "a Company of U. States' Troops passed through Decatur, Dekalb county, a few days since, to push off the gold diggers from the Indian territory. Report says resistance is threatened."—*Statesman*.

This must be a mistake. We have intelligence from Lawrenceville of a later date than the above, and have heard nothing of these troops having received such instructions. They are stationed at Cedar Creek for the purpose of arresting further aggressions on the part of the Indians. Col. Montgomery, the agent is engaged in removing the gold diggers, but as yet has employed no force.—*Ed. Athenian*.
