

*The Cherokee country.*—The Recorder of 4th inst says: "Three additional companies of U. S. Troops—~~one~~ of artillery from Charleston, the other two of infantry, one from Augusta, and the other from Fort-Mitchell—under the command of Maj. Wager, have, we understand, been ordered to proceed forthwith to the Cherokee country to repress the working of the mines. This step is understood to be acquiesced in by the Governor. The state's Agent has not been able to prevent intrusion and great waste in this section, and has consequently been recalled. Should circumstances still appear to render it necessary, it is thought it may be found expedient to convene the Legislature on the third Monday in October.
