

We understand that the committee on the state of the Republic, on Wednesday last reported a bill to survey the Cherokee territory, for the purpose of more effectually extending over it the jurisdiction of the State, and ascertaining the precise extent of country belonging to each of the frontier counties. It is thought that the Legislature will not resolve to go immediately into the occupancy of this country, but will wait till it is ascertained whether the General Government will be successful in the efforts now making peaceably to remove the Indians. In the event of the withdrawal of the U. States troops, it is expected that the Governor will be authorized to raise a military force sufficient to prevent depredations upon the gold mines within the Indian territory.
