

At an adjourned term of the Superior Court for Hall county, held last week, *George Tassels*, a Cherokee Indian, was convicted of the murder of another Indian, and sentenced to be hung on the 24th of December next. It is expected that an effort will be made on the part of Tassels to carry the case before the Supreme Court of the United States. On the right of the jurisdiction of that Court over cases arising between this State and the Indians, there are various opinions among the gentlemen of the bar; but as far as we can judge, it is probable the Supreme Court of the United States will not interfere in the decision of our Court on this question.
