In the *Senate* yesterday, the consideration of Mr. Clay's resolution was renewed, and Mr. Tyler spoke about one hour in opposition to it, when he gave way to a motion to proceed to executive business; in the consideration of which, some time was spent.

In the *House of Rep.* Mr. Davis of South Carolina, from the committee on the Judiciary, reported a bill concerning naturalization. The House resumed the consideration of the apportionment bill. Mr. Clayton moved a reconsideration of the vote of yesterday, whereby 48,000 was stricken from the bill, and 44,400 inserted in lieu thereof, but before the question was taken the house adjourned.
