

ANOTHER MEETING IN SAVANNAH.—A meeting was held in Savannah on the 12th inst. to take into consideration the subject of the removal of the deposits, from the Bank of the United States, and for publicly expressing their opinions in relation thereto, which resulted favorably for the measures of the Administration. The resolutions introduced praying for the restoration of the deposits to the U. S. Bank, were voted down by a decided majority. The Georgian remarks, "We are satisfied that if the sense of the people of this city, or of Chatham county, were taken on the subject, there would be an overwhelming majority in favor of the measures of the Administration. We believe that but few, opposed to the Administration, were absent when the vote was taken."
