

**Milledgeville "CONVENTION."**—The eyes of the nullification party are now turned to this place of "Central dictation," with great anxiety. The nomination of *Judge Clayton* by *Pemberton*, has produced confusion in their ranks, and they begin to apprehend, unless something is done to keep their party "in gear," there will be not only defections, but open rebellion.
