

☞ The nullification Convention assembled to nominate a candidate to be run by that party for Governor, met at Milledgeville on Monday last, and was organized by appointing JOHN McPHERSON BERRIEN, Esq. President, and Col. WM. S. ROCKWELL, Secretary.— Sixty-two counties are said to have been represented. IN THE SECOND BAND, GEORGE R. GILMER, Esq. having a majority of the votes, was nominated for Governor.
