IN COUNCIL, November 18, 1786.

A Communication from Thomas Napier, and Thomas Carnes, Esqrs. of this day, making a resignation of their appointments as signers and numberers of the Bills of Credit of the denominations of Twenty and Ten shillings; Thomas Napier, Esq. having signed and numbered as far as 6720, and Thomas P.
