rst. We prefent as a grievance of an alarming nature, Thomas P. Carnes, Judge of the western circuit, for adminif. tering the oath of quilification of members of the house of representatives to a member in a partial manner; infomuch that an addition was made to the fame by the person qualifying; whereby the confritution of the flate of Georgia, had it not been over-ruled, would have been twifted, turned, and at last brought into contempt. And we do further prefent, that two of our members supported the fame member in his fear, and actually on the yeas and nays being taken, gave their negative to his being compelled to take the faid eath, without referve, and after coming forward, and qualifying agreea. bly to the conflitution, the minutes refpecting this unpleafant bufinels, and which call the flate great expence, were eraied from the rough journals.
