*Ordered,*

THAT the clause of the tax act relative to the election of Receivers of tax returns and Collectors of tax—The clause of the Estray law, requiring the clerks of the Superior to pay over to the clerks of the Inferior courts, all monies in their hands, which have arisen from the sale of Estrays—The act to alter the time of the meeting of the Superior courts of this State—The act to amend an act for improving the navigation of Broad and Oconee rivers—And, the act explanatory, and to amend that part of the judiciary act, passed in the year 1797, which respects justices courts—be published in the several Gazettes of this State, for the immediate information of the officers and citizens thereof.
