

NOTIFICATION

To Tax Collectors and Sheriffs.

This Collection for the year 1807, and those for the year 1806, who are still in arrears, are notified, that until the tenth day of November next will be allowed them to make final settlements of their account. Such collectors as had it not in their power to get their insolvent lists certified by the Grand Juries, at the Spring Circuit of the Superior courts, will do well to avail themselves of the opportunity which will be afforded for doing so, at the ensuing fall circuit, for executions will affixedly issue immediately after the day above mentioned against those whose accounts are not then closed.

The Sheriffs, to whom executions against Collectors have been already forwarded, are required to report to me, without delay, all proceedings which have been had thereon.
