WHEREAS, the order of the 20th of January last has not been uniformly complied with—therefore, for the purpose of preventing any future misapprehension of its terms and object, it is further

ORDERED, That every application for any portion of the Poor School Fund must be made on the authority of a majority of the Trustees, and accompanied by the following certificate, signed by a majority of the Justices of the Inferior Court, viz:

"We do hereby certify, that the whole amount of the Poor School Fund heretofore received for the county of _____, has been faithfully applied to the education of Poor children according to law, as satisfactorily appears from the statement and exhibit made to us by the Trustees of said Fund"
