

The menaced Extermination is achieved.—The Election of State House officers commenced on Friday the 16th inst at 11 o'clock, A. M. and concluded at half past four in the evening. The pretext was, that the Jackson members did not vote for William H. Crawford for Judge of the Northern Circuit. Hollow as the pretext was, it was openly avowed; and for no better reason than this, the dominant party now displaced from the office of Secretary of State, the venerable Gen. Newnan—grey with industrious age, and infirm with the toils and decrepitudes of war. His life had often been jeopardized in the "imminent deadly breach," and his body lacerated and mangled, while he stood as a wall of defence between these his fellow-citizens, and the incrimsoned tomahawk; the dear ones of their own hearth had slept securely under the soldiers vigil, and felt nothing of the sanguinary conflicts, privations, and alarms that emaciated his form—and yet these, his fellow-citizens could wrest from him even the little that he had, and cast him off in the declension of his days, penniless and unrewarded, to seek yet another occasion to pour out his life for their own and their country's welfare, or to exercise his christian virtues by reflecting that it is the cruelty of Aristocracies to turn a deaf ear to the demands of patriotism and gratitude.
