COMMENCEMENT.—The final Examination of the present Senior Class, in this Institution, will take place on Monday the 7th of July. The Examination of the Freshman Class, on Wednesday the 30th, and of the Sophomore Class, on Thursday the 31st of the same month. On Friday the 1st day of August, the Junior Class will be examined, and on Saturday the 2d, the Candidates for admission into College. On Sabbath, the 3d, a Commencement Sermon will be delivered in the Presbyterian Church in Athens; on Monday the Board of Trustees will meet; on Tuesday, the 5th, a part of the members of the Junior Class attached to the two Societies in College will deliver Orations of their own composition; and Wednesday the 6th day of August, will be the Annual Commencement. During the occasion, an Oration will be delivered by Judge Clayton, and also, by Judge Berrien, as Representatives of the Demosthenian and Phi Kappa Societies.
