WHEREAS *John Taylor,*
John Stare, Mrs. Bugg, sen. Mrs.
Bugg, jun. Samuel Bugg, Jacob
Bugg, Mrs. Heron, George Wal-
ton, Robert Watkins, Richard
Carns, Henry Turkquet, Mr.
Jordene, and Mr. Clem. were
duly summoned agreeable to law,
on the 26th October, 1787, to
attend personally, and with their
male slaves from the age of 16
to 60 years, to work on the
public road leading from the
town of Augusta to Spirit Creek,
and to continue thereon for six
days from that time, and several
made default: These are there-
fore to give notice, that the Com-
missioners of the said road will
attend at the house of *Mr. Fox,*
in Augusta, on Monday next,
at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, to
receive the excuses of the said
defaulters, if any they have; and
fine all such as do not shew law-
ful cause to the contrary.
