

ACTS.

Passed by the last Legislature of the state of Georgia.

AN ACT

To establish a ware-house and inspection of tobacco on lands of John D. Terrell, on Tugaloo river, in Franklin county,

BE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Georgia, in General Assembly met, That there shall be an inspection of tobacco and a ware house established on lands of John D. Terrell, on Tugaloo river, in Franklin county, on the Bluff which borders on the Indian town below Mullin's Ford, the place to be called ——— Witten.

Sec. 2. *And be it further enacted, That James H. Little, Thomas P. Carnes,*

Larklin Cleveland and John D. Terrell,
he appointed to lay off the same; which
said ware-house shall be subject to such
rules and regulations as other ware-houses
in this state now are, or hereafter may be.
